Indications:

Orthopaedy

- Treatment after joint and intervertebral disc surgery (endo-prosthesis implants, cervical and lumbar nucleotomy)
- Treatment after sport and other accidental injury
- Degenerative and inflammatory rheumatic disease of the vertebral column and extremities
- Treatment after one or both sided amputation of the lower extremities
- Osteoporosis
- In-patient hand surgery rehabilitation
- Rehabilitation of patients with burns
- Interdisciplinary treatment for chronic pain syndromes of the locomotor system

Neurology

- Apoplexia and cerebral haemorrhage
- Craniocerebral injury
- Inflammation of peripheral nervous system, incl. the Guillain-Barré-Syndrome
- Medulla injuries, e.g. after accidents or degenerative vertebral cord diversifications
- All other disease of the central and peripheral nervous system, incl. epilepsy and muscle disease
- Treatment of chronic pain syndromes
- Morbus Parkinson
- Multiple sclerosis
- Interdisciplinary traumatology

We have specially equipped and observed places for rehabilitation after coma and post-anoxic state (e.g. apallics) in our intensive care.
